#### **Open Gala Champion**

Points accumulated from class 13 Open Grand Prix (mandatory to start in this class), plus points from 2 of the following classes:

- Class 7 (1.10m); and
- Either Class 12 (Open 1m) **OR** class 17 Open (1.10m)

#### **Restricted Gala Champion**

Points accumulated from Class 4 Restricted Grand Prix (mandatory to start in this class), plus points from the following classes:

- Class 3 (Novice 70cm); and
- Either Class 15 (Novice 70cm) **OR** Class 16 (Elementary 80cm)

Horses are only permitted to compete in 1 x Grand Prix class – this means either the Restricted Grand Prix or the Open Grand Prix, but not both.

### **General Conditions**

**Maximum Classes** – horses may be entered in a maximum of 3 classes per day. Horses that are entered in a class for which it is not eligible to compete in will automatically be listed as HC on the draw. The 3 classes does not include the Novelty Table C or Ride & Drive – you can enter these in addition to the 3 standard classes.

**Dress** – dress regulations are in accordance with the EA Jumping Rules. In addition to these rules, the following dress regulations will apply for this event:

- Jackets are optional
- If no jacket is worn, shirts must not be sleeveless
- Shirts must be tucked in and collar done up
- Long sleeved shirts must have sleeves rolled down and buttoned
- Polo shirts and fishing style shirts are not permitted
- Jodhpurs/breeches must be white, beige, light beige or similar light colour. Coloured jodhpurs/breeches are not permitted ie: black, blue, purple, patterned etc

**Rules** – all events are run under FEI, EA or DSJC rules as applicable. It is the sole responsibility of competitors to ensure they are aware of all relevant rules.
